



# FireWall™ 50 WP Replaces FireWall™ 17 WP for Citrus Canker on Florida Grapefruit Under Section 18 Exemption



## Technical Bulletin – No. 7

A Section 18 (emergency exemption) has been granted by the EPA allowing use of **FireWall™ 50 WP** to combat citrus canker (*Xanthomonas citri* *pv.* *citri*) on commercially-grown grapefruit in Florida. FireWall™ 17 WP is not permitted for application to Florida grapefruit; only **FireWall™ 50 WP** may be used under the terms of the Section 18 approved by the EPA for **FireWall™ 50 WP** until June 12, 2015.

**FireWall™ 50 WP** is equivalent to FireWall™ 17 WP, except that it has nearly 3 times more active ingredient per pound compared to FireWall™ 17 WP. This means much less product to transport, store and handle and significantly fewer empty bags and cartons left for disposal.

All application instructions and restrictions that applied to the previously granted Section 18 label for FireWall™ 17 WP apply to the Section 18 label for **FireWall™ 50 WP** as well. See table below for basic recommendations and information regarding the use of **FireWall™ 50 WP** for citrus canker on Florida grapefruit.

Application Rate:	11 oz. per acre; applied a maximum of two (2) times.
Maximum Amt./Season:	22 oz. per acre
Minimum Interval between Applications:	21 days
REI, PHI:	Re-entry interval (REI): 12 hours. Pre-harvest interval (PHI): 60 days.
Integrate with Copper:	Tank-mix FireWall with <i>reduced rates</i> of copper; application of copper bactericides prior to and following FireWall™ strongly recommended.
Apply FireWall™ 50 WP:	When crop expert or FDACS determines weather conditions favor canker and increased risk of phytotoxicity from copper sprays exists.

All applicable directions, restrictions, and precautions on the EPA-registered label for **FireWall™ 50 WP** must be followed as well as those on the Section 18 label for **FireWall™ 50 WP**. Refer to the **FireWall™ 50 WP** Section 18 label for additional information and/or restrictions regarding its application to Florida grapefruit. Always read and follow label instructions.
